Pupils form Year 10—Year13 have also benefitted from hearing from the careers advisers for the Royal Navy, Army and RAF. Pupils taking PE A level and BTEC Sport courses enjoyed a very informative day at the University of Marjon. Year 9 have been making use of the website Careerpilot and other careers resources during their tutor time to help them make their GCSE option choices. Next half term Year 10 will be looking at careers during their PSHE lessons.
