

Driver

To work as part of a small team and be the primary minibus driver for the school's home /school transport provision.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Operate one of the school's bus routes, collecting children from pick up points along the route and delivering to school and where applicable, collecting pupils from school and returning to the designated drop off points.
- Keep a register of pupils using the transport
- Responsible for the Health and Safety and general welfare of pupils travelling ensuring appropriate precautions before and during the journey i.e. wearing seat belts and behaving appropriately
- Ensure the minibus is clean, tidy inside and out and in a roadworthy condition
- Undertake regular inspection of the minibus and report defects to the Transport Officer
- Regularly visual check vehicle including tyres, lights, oil, water, fuel etc
- Refuel vehicle as required
- Adhere to school policies and guidelines
- Attend appropriate training as required for the role
