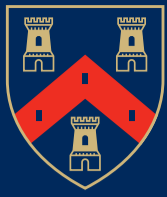

Role	Job Description	No	Staff Mentor
Senior Leadership Roles			
Heads of School	Heads of School are senior pupil leaders who represent the school, support events, assemblies, visitors, and fundraising. This role would suit pupils who are confident, responsible, and keen to lead and represent the school.	6	LET
Heads of House	Heads of House lead and motivate their House, encouraging House Points, organising events, and contributing to assemblies. This role would suit pupils who enjoy teamwork, leadership, and motivating others.	8	LET
Ambassadors and Leaders			
Sports Ambassadors	Sports Ambassadors help encourage participation in sport across the school. They support sports events and fixtures, promote teamwork and fair play, and act as positive role models. This role would suit pupils who enjoy sport, show good sportsmanship, and like motivating others.	6	HCTS
Boarding Leaders	Boarding Leaders support the day-to-day life of the Boarding House and work closely with the Houseparents. This role would suit pupils who are caring, organised, and enjoy being part of the boarding community.	2	VP
Nature Ambassadors	Nature Ambassadors help care for the school environment and work with the Assistant Head (Nature) on eco-projects and outdoor initiatives. This role would suit pupils who care about the environment and enjoy practical, outdoor work.	1 or 2	KK
Modern Foreign Languages Ambassadors	Modern Foreign Languages Ambassadors help promote enthusiasm for languages across the school. They support language activities and events, encourage pupils to practise their language skills, and help celebrate different cultures. This role would suit pupils who enjoy learning languages, are confident speaking in class, and like encouraging others.	TBC	ATRL

Reading Buddies Leaders	Reading Buddies Leaders help organise the Reading Buddy programme and support younger pupils with reading. This role would suit pupils who enjoy reading, are organised, and like supporting younger pupils.	4	CLP
PL Monitor	The PL Monitor helps make the PL space welcoming and supports pupils who are new to the department. This role would suit pupils who are kind, approachable, and good at helping others feel included.	1	CM
Music Leaders	Music Leaders promote a love of music by performing at concerts, encouraging participation, and supporting music initiatives. This role would suit pupils who enjoy performing and inspiring others through music.	2	ERT
Art Leaders	Art Leaders support the Art Department by helping keep the Art Room organised and promoting creativity. This role would suit pupils who enjoy art, creativity, and helping keep spaces organised.	2	JCT
Assembly Correspondent	The Assembly Correspondent listens carefully during assemblies and school events and writes short reports for the school newsletter. This role would suit pupils who enjoy writing, listen carefully, and pay attention to detail.	1	EN
Chess Monitor	The Chess Monitor helps organise chess at break or lunchtime, setting up equipment and encouraging fair play. This role would suit pupils who enjoy chess, are patient, and like helping others.	1	PWD
Peer Mentor	Peer Mentors help support other pupils by being friendly and approachable and helping younger or new pupils feel welcome. This role would suit pupils who are kind, trustworthy, and good listeners.	4	LET/PWD
Technology Ambassador	Technology Ambassadors help school events run smoothly by setting up and operating technology for assemblies and school plays and promoting responsible use of technology. This role would suit pupils who enjoy using technology, are reliable, and can solve problems calmly.	2	TBC
Lunch Duty Monitor	Lunch Duty Monitors help ensure lunchtimes run smoothly by supporting staff, helping younger pupils, and encouraging good manners. This role would suit pupils who are responsible, polite, and happy to help others.	2	PWD
Communication & Marketing Correspondent	The Communication & Marketing Correspondent helps share positive news about school life through newsletters, displays, or other communications. This role would suit pupils who enjoy writing, being creative, and sharing news with others.	1 or 2	TBC
Library Leaders	Library Leaders help keep the library tidy, promote reading, and share book recommendations. This role would suit pupils who enjoy reading and encouraging others to discover books.	2	EN

Flag Monitor	The Flag Monitor ensures the school flag is displayed correctly and changed on the appropriate day. This role would suit pupils who are responsible and take pride in doing a job carefully.	1	PWD
Firelighter	The Firelighter helps ensure the Head's room is warm during the winter months by lighting the fire and bringing in logs. This role would suit pupils who are reliable and happy carrying out a regular practical task.	1	LET
